
Question 1 asked . . .


Question 2 asked . . .

Almost 350 TOEIC cycles have been completed by SUAC students. Almost 300 students have started working on the second TOEIC cycle. These results tell us that many SUAC students have done at least three hours of homework using the online system and they are still working hard. SUAC students never surrender.


Question 3 asked

What are the average results for SUAC English Diploma (EDC) students using the online TOEIC system?

Our results from question 3 show that ...

On some sections of the TOEIC system, EDC students have scored above 75%. Among SUAC students using this system, the EDC students have the highest averages. Students who work hard and use the system regularly over a long period of time will improve their scores. EDC students are great.

Question 4 asked

Do students improve their accuracy in answering TOEIC questions from the first cycle to the third?

Our results from question 4 show that . . .

The number of correct answers to TOEIC questions increases the more students practice. Students answered below 50% of the questions correctly in the first cycle; however, these figures improved to higher than 50% in the third cycle. SUAC students are quick learners.
